

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

It is the Policy of Regal London Ltd to plan and perform all development and construction projects in an environmentally sensitive manner so as to minimise adverse environmental impacts. Every member of the organisation is committed to continual improvement in the fulfilment of our environmental legal obligations and other requirements to which we subscribe, in ensuring the conservation of resources, the prevention of pollution and the elimination of environmental hazards which may be associated with our activities.

To ensure achievement of this Policy, an Environmental Management System will be established to meet the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2004.

Our environmental policy is to:

- Prevent pollution and reduce the potential impact which our operations may have on the environment through the adoption of robust controls for preventing air, ground, water and noise pollution.
- Maintain our knowledge of and comply with all legislation, regulations and codes of practice on environmental matters relevant to our operations.
- Monitor, audit and review the effectiveness of our Environmental Management System in order to ensure compliance with environmental standards and to identify opportunities for continual improvement.
- Work in partnership with our consultants, subcontractors and suppliers to promote the sourcing of sustainable products and services and encourage them to adopt environmental policies and management systems compatible with our own.
- Set annual objectives and targets and monitor our performance against these, in order to demonstrate continual improvement.
- To ensure that this Policy and supporting processes are understood and communicated within the organisation and is made available to the public.

Regal London Ltd will endeavour to ensure that all relevant aspects of good Environmental Management are effective in operation and that the all persons working with and for our organisation are fully aware of their roles and responsibilities in this regard.

As Chairman of Construction, I, and the Senior Management team are directly responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy across the business.
